## **Federal University of Pará - UFPA**

### **Presentation**

The Federal University of Pará – UFPA is located in Belém, capital city of the State of Pará, in the Amazon Region, Northern Brazil. It was founded in July 1957, and since then has been the leading university of the Amazon Region.

High standard academic programs are offered to more than 31,000 students attending 240 undergraduate courses, plus 2,500 students attending 73 graduate courses, and more than 4,000 students attending several other courses offered to the internal and external communities. The competent teaching staff is composed of more than 2,400 professors and instructors in the campus of Belém, and nine campuses located in other cities of the State of Pará.

It articulates and supports international relations aiming at the development of projects, programs, and joint actions in the field of international cooperation. 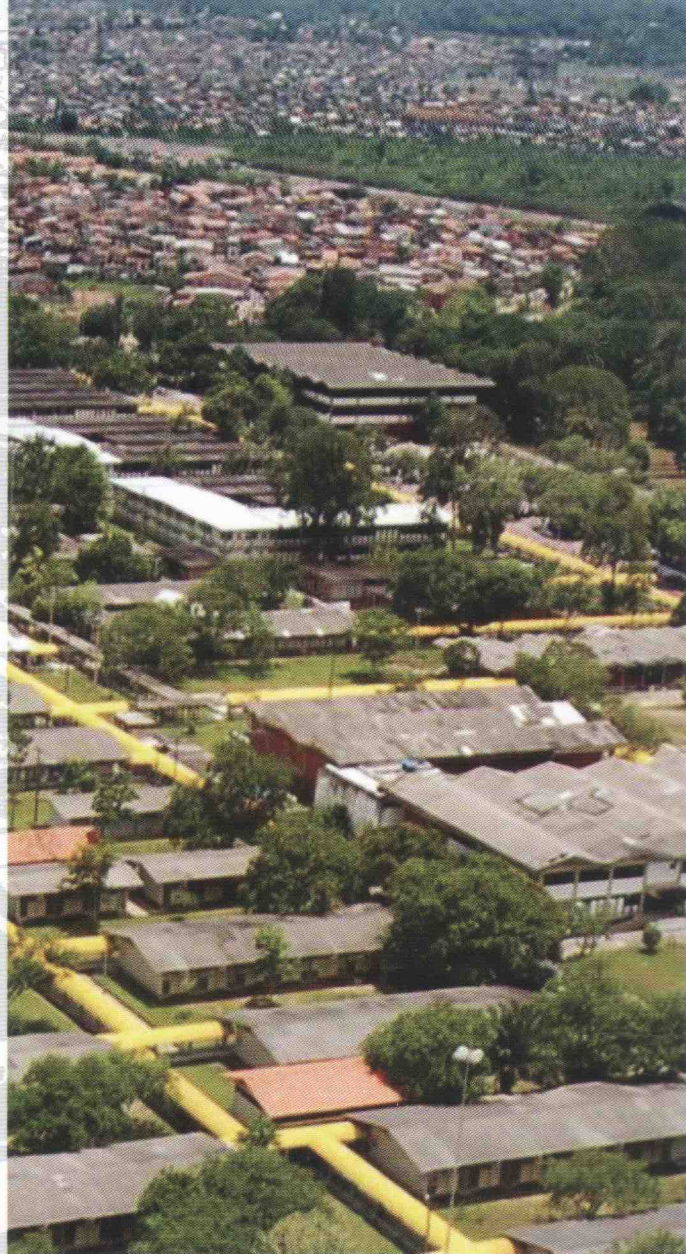
